WHY COMMONWEALTH AFRICA?

· CTEF need to identify regional focus.

 The consultant has identified Commonwealth Africa (for now we will focus on Commonwealth Africa).

 If collaborative efforts are in placed these could be expanded to other regions of the Commonwealth.



THIS MEETING

 We have invited CTEF's network partners, potential partners and organizations having interest in Africa, such as the AADUN, Malaysia's Global Reach, RMIT (Prof. D Cuthbert, who has been conducting several workshops on doctoral education).

 IAU and ACU were specially invited as they have done important work on doctoral education in Africa.





OUTPUT FROM THIS MEETING

• Endorsement from MoE, network partners and other partners that Doctoral Education is a worthwhile topic to purse in Commonwealth Africa.
